In July, 1995, the Chime Master carillon system was installed at Good Shepherd Lutheran Church. This system was purchased through a gift received from the estate of one of our members.

Since that time, this system has afforded us an opportunity to share with our community many wonderful sounds, from the chiming of the hour to a variety of musical selections.

The selecting and scheduling of time for various songs or tolling of the bells is made so easy that we are able to program different functions for different times of the day, for which we take advantage. Currently, the carillons are programmed to strike the hour at 12 noon and 6 p.m. with music selections following fifteen minutes later. The system has also been programmed for a "Call to Worship" tolling seven minutes prior to the two scheduled Sunday worship services. When a church service appears to run past the scheduled program times for the carillons, we find that the system is easy to override. We also appreciate the ability to play a selection(s) one time for a special event.

We also found it very appropriate to play "Taps" at the end of the day and it was well received in the community.

Our neighbors have indicated their pleasure in hearing the carillons and have requested that music be played more often during the day.
